



- ✓ Asserted important of human rights
- ✓ Recognised help needed for developing countries
- ✓ Argued for safeguarding natural resources and their capacity for renewal

Declaration on Environment & Development

Goal of establishing a new and equitable global partnership through

- creation of new levels of cooperation
- international agreements respecting all interests and protect the integrity of the global environmental and developmental system
- recognizing the integral and interdependent nature of the Earth




1. Achieving a equitable balance between the elements






2. Rich countries doing fine but are they helping the poorer nations?
